

Dear OSAS Foster Care Provider:

OSAS is occasionally in need of new foster homes in various locations across Ontario. We cover all necessary expenses incurred for vets, farrier and the boarding fee of up to \$10 per day. This can be paid directly to you monthly or you may choose to donate those services and receive a tax receipt. Fees may be adjusted lower for pasture board horses that are not in training. All foster farms must have a minimum of one million liability insurance and have experience in horse care. Unless you would only be fostering senior/companion horses, experience in training horses would also be required. All grain is generously provided by Masterfeeds.

Please complete the following questionnaire and return it to the office by fax or mail. We will call for more information if we are in need of a foster home in your area. Generally, horses would stay in foster care anywhere from 2-9 months before being placed into a permanent adoptive home. Senior/companion horses may stay longer in foster care. Thank you for your interest.
